**Note:**

- The minimum age for enrolling a child in Class 'A' shall be completion of 4 years of age by 30<sup>th</sup> April of the current academic session. This is applicable for both Government and Private schools.
- School timing for every School both Government and Private:- Classes A & B: - 8:30 AM to 12:30 PM, Classes 1 & 2: - 8:30 AM to 2PM, Classes 3- 12: - 8:30AM to 3 PM.
- Every Government and Private school is to compulsorily conduct School Activities and also observe 10 Bagless Days for Classes 6 to 8 on 1<sup>st</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> Saturdays.
- Maintain the number of Instructional Days ie 180 Days.
- Every Government and Private school is to observe Cultural Day on 1<sup>st</sup> Saturday of October.
- All General Holidays notified by the Government of Nagaland should compulsorily be observed as State / National holidays along with 3 (three) local restricted holidays.
- Every school shall follow examinations/ assessments scheduled as notified by the NBSE/SCERT.
- Events of National importance notified by Government of India shall be observed by all schools functioning within the State of Nagaland.
- Every Government and Private school shall conduct social work/ Swachhata activities at least once in a month.
