SWACHHATA PAKWADA

- **Swachhata Pakhwada started in April 2016 with the objective of bringing a fortnight of intense focus on the issues and practices of Swachhata by engaging GOI Ministries/Departments in their jurisdictions**
- **An annual calendar is pre-circulated among the Ministries to help them plan for the Pakhwada activities. In the Ministry of Education, Swachhata Pakwada is organized from 1st to 15th Sept.**
- **Detailed instructions along with suggested day wise activities have been communicated to all the States / UTs / ABs.**
- **State / UT wise, day wise and activity wise details are being collected through Google Tracker**

Day – Wise suggested Action Plan for Swachhata Pakhwada, 2022

(1st -15th September)



01.09.2022 (Thursday)

Swachhata Shapath Day

- Swachhata Shapath function may be organized wherein all students and teachers/staff may participate.
- Swachhata/COVID awareness message to be posted on the website of the Department/Organisations/Schools.
- Upload the number of students who took Swachhata Shapath and the number of schools participated on Google tracker and photos, videos and publicity material on Google drive.



02.09.2022 (Friday)

Swachhata Awareness Day

- * Holding meeting of SMCs/ PTAs to highlight the importance of cleanliness & sanitation and importance of Hand-washing.
- * Teachers to inspect sanitary facilities in each and every corner of school/ institution to do a quick assessment and make proposal/plan for upkeep of the facilities.
- * COVID- 19 sensitive adaptation for WASH facilities (hand wash facility, daily cleaning and disinfection, toilet/ urinal use, water facility use, ventilation, waste management, O&M etc) may be discussed.
- * A status check/review can be done for piped water supply connection in the school in view of Jal Jeevan mission.
- * A status check and augmentation plan with regard to water harvesting systems in the school may be taken up in view of the current Jal Shakti Abhiyan - Catch The Rain, 2022 campaign
- * Extensive cleaning/disinfection of toilets, MDM kitchen, classrooms, fans, doors, windows, clearing bushes in the campus to be undertaken.
- * All kinds of waste material like broken furniture, unusable equipment, defunct vehicles etc. should be completely removed from the premises of schools/institutions.



3.9.2022 and 4.9.2022
(Saturday & Sunday)

Community Outreach Day

- Parenting Seminars may be organised on the theme of Swachhata.
- Teachers and students in association with local representatives may propagate the theme of Swachhata Pakhwada, Covid appropriate behaviour and vaccination among public in local areas.



05.09.2022 (Monday)

Green School Drive Days

- Students may be asked to come out with imaginative slogans, posters and pamphlets on themes such as fighting Corona water conservation, eliminating single use plastic etc,
- To sensitize students about the impact of scarcity of water.

06.09.2022 and 7.9.2022 (Tuesday & Wednesday)

Swachhata Participation Days

- Competitions can be held in districts/blocks/clusters for clean and well-maintained premises and toilets in schools.
- Organizing Painting, Skit, Poem-making, slogan writing competitions on Swachhata.

8.9.2022 and 9.9.2022 (Thursday & Friday)

Hand Wash Day

- Create Awareness on the need for proper hand wash in daily life.
- Children may be taught proper method/steps/moments, timings of hand washing with soap before and after eating.
- Water from hand washing unit to be channelled to school gardens.
- Children may be taught about the water borne diseases/diseases, safe handling of drinking water so that they practice proper hand and oral hygiene.

10.09.2022 and 11.9.2022 (Saturday & Sunday)

Personal Hygiene Days

- Audio visual programme to be undertaken to motivate students/employees and other for maintaining cleanliness.
- Students may be made aware about proper way of cutting and keeping nails clean, daily bathing with clean water, wearing clean cloths, no spitting in open, wearing shoes/ slippers etc.
- Students may be taught the hygienic manner of using toilets and drinking water facilities. Students may be made aware of the importance of brushing teeth twice a day by making it routine habit.

13.09.2022 and 14.09.2022 (Tuesday & Wednesday)

Swachhata Action Plan Days

- SMC to create awareness among students, parents and local people about the Swachhata Action Plan
- Convene small group meeting of Bal Sansad / School Cabinet specially to discuss the Swachhata Pakhwada activities in the school.
- Encourage community members and students to make suggestions as to what new activities can be included under Swachhata Pakhwada and forward such suggestions to DoSEL, MoE.

12.09.2022 (Monday)

Swachhata School Exhibition Days

- Photographs, paintings, cartoons, slogans etc. made by students on Swachhata activities/Covid response behaviors may be displayed in School/Education Department's website.
- Making artefacts at home using local recycled-raw material for storage of waste i.e., artistic dustbins using local skills promoting their culture.

15.09.2022 (Thursday)

Prize Distribution Day

Prize distribution for participation of children, teachers and parents in competitions viz. Painting, Essay, Debate, Quiz, Slogan, Inter-school and Crafting, model making etc. using waste to encourage Swachhata

Steps for accessing the Swachhata Pakhwada Google Tracker and Drive – 2022 are given below:

- **User must have Gmail account.**
- **Two User ID's (Gmail id) per State /UT will be given access from which the data would get uploaded on Swachhta Pakhwada tracker.**
- **Send the request on “moe.swachhatapakhwada22@gmail.com” for having access to Google tracker and drive.**
- **The data needs to be updated daily by 8.00 PM for day specific activity along with High Resolution photographs, videos and other publicity material.**
- **After getting the permission for accessing the tracker:**
 - User can simply login into their registered Gmail account,
 - Copy the available link of tracker and paste in browser (Google chrome),
 - Swachhata Pakhwada Tracker will open,
 - Go to your State/UT specific row, update the information for daily activity as mentioned in tracker.
 - User may directly upload or add the material in their State/UT folder available on Google drive from the link as provided. (drive link as provided)
